## **FINANCIAL REPORT**

#### Main Income

The Ministry of Foreign Aff airs of the Netherlands is the main funder of Share-Net International and the country nodes in the Netherlands, Bangladesh, Burundi and Jordan. Share-Net members form the back bone of the network; it exists both for them and as a result of their hard work and contributions. In addition to their valuable inspiration and intellectual input, Share-Net Netherlands members also contributed fi nancially to support the network. Besides their annual membership fee, members invited guest speakers from abroad, off ered meeting locations and provided for networking opportunities.

#### **Main Costs**

Spending is well within budget in 2016. The remaining underspend € 375.153 is mainly due to the delay in the start of activities in Jordan, political unrest in Burundi and remaining small grants payments. These funds will be carried over and used in 2017.
