- =The principal global intergovernmental body exclusively dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women since
- =consisting of 45 members
- =a leading role in monitoring and reviewing progress and problems in the implementation of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action
- =mainstreaming a gender perspective in UN activities

About the CSW proces

Negotiations take place from Jan-March on the draft Agreed Conclusions & the Multi-Year Program of Work (MYPOW) 2017-2019 between Member States

= Negotiations end in March during CSW in NY

Role of NGOs

 Give input on zero draft and MYPOW towards government delegations

Present Dutch Civil Society Priorities towards Dutch delegation

Presence in NY during negotations – coordination WO=MEN, Atria and NVR

=NGO/CSO forum – parallel events during the CSW

CSW60: theme

=Priority theme: Women's empowerment and the link to sustainable development

= Review theme: The elimination and prevention of all forms of violence against women and girls (agreed conclusions from the fifty-seventh session)

Zero draft CSW

- =Language needs to be consistent and inclusive
- =Very important 'gender equality, human rights and the empowerment of all women and girls' is included in the document
- =Reference to male involvement/role of men and boys
- =Reference to SRHR
- =And many other key terms...

MYPOW 2017-2019

- =Multi-Year Programme of Work (MYPOW)
- =Determines how CSW will function in coming years & what will be discussed...
- Determines possibilities for Civil society participation
- =Last year's (CSW59) agreed conclusion guaranteed CSO participation without restrictions

Two-pager NGO/CSO CSW60

- =Focus on Reaffirmation of previous conventions, agreements, Beijing Platform for Action...
- = Dutch CSOs decided to focus within SDGs on:
 - =Climate
 - = Migration

=Through Parliament...

- =AO Emancipation Feb 10 minister Bussemaker
- =AO Inclusive development in development cooperation March 9 minister Ploumen

Challenges

=CSW59 experienced a setback. Mainly because the link between gender equality and human rights was not reflected in the Political Declaration

=Unholy Alliance (Russia, Qatar, Iran) but now also China

=The Netherlands being chair of EU, can't be as progressive
